When I book my tickets, which city should I fly in and out of?

Our tour begins and ends in New Delhi (capital of India). You can fly in and out of Indira Gandhi International Airport.

When should I book my arrivals and departure for?

The tour begins on Mar 18 and ends on the 30th. You can arrive as early as the 16th or 17th of March and let us know so we can hold the bookings for you in the same hotel as where the tour begins. As per your request, the rates will be shared with you at the time of booking the extra nights.

Once we come back to Delhi on the 30th, the night of the 30th is NOT included in the tour cost. If you'd like us to book you a hotel, please let us know.

Passport

Please make sure your passports are valid and you obtain the visa in time for the trip. Your passport needs to be valid for at least six (6) months after your journey ends and should have a minimum of two (2) blank visa pages for entry and exit stamps. If you need to acquire or renew a passport, it may take 6 weeks to 3 months to process passport renewal.

Visa

A tourist visa is required for entry into India and must be obtained prior to departure. You can apply for the e-visa here: <https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/evisa/tvoa.html>

To be eligible the traveller must:

- Traveling for a 180 day or less stay in India
- Submit for the e-Visa no less than 7 days and no more than 120 days prior to entry into India
- Must be arriving by air or sea at specific airports and seaports

In case the option for e-visa is not available for your country, please contact the appropriate consular office for entry requirements. If your stay in India is longer, you will need a Regular Visa

Vaccinations

There is no vaccination certificate required to visit India for traveller's arriving from America & North America unless you are traveling via an African country. Most travel clinics suggest traveller's take vaccinations for Hepatitis A and B as well as Typhoid. We strongly suggest that you visit your local travel clinic to review your individual situation to determine what vaccines you need.

Travellers Insurance

We suggest that you be fully covered with theft, loss and especially medical policies. Before your departure from the U.S., review your existing health and homeowner's policies. We are not responsible or liable for loss, damage or theft of personal luggage and belongings, nor can we be liable for personal injury, accident or illness. In most foreign countries, insurance coverage of personal injury, accident or illness is not available based on US standards. That is why we strongly urge you to check with your insurance agent to make sure you are adequately covered. You can purchase additional insurance from your insurance broker to cover luggage, personal effects and accident and health. We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation insurance.

Currency Exchange & Credit Card Usage

When you arrive in India, you can simply withdraw \$100-\$150 from the ATM at the airport in India Rs. It's the easiest and cheapest option to start with. You can also carry some \$s if you want to exchange money, which the travel agent will help you with. The old \$100 don't work here for exchange and if they do, they cost more. So, if you are planning on carrying \$100 bills, please try and get the new ones. The safest option is withdrawing from an ATM and also, you can use your international credit card most places. Just be sure to inform your bank before traveling.

Wifi & Phone Connectivity

We will be staying in 5-star properties with free Wifi access. Most cafes and restaurants also have wifi. You can get an international sim card in India or activate your international roaming plan in the US in case you wish to have additional access.
